### **Visitor Centers**

Hulls Cove Visitor Center is open from mid-April through October. Hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (6:00 p.m. in July and August).

The Winter Visitor Center is located at the Chamber of Commerce at 2 Cottage Street in Bar Harbor.

Thompson Island Visitor Center is located on Route 3 as you approach the head of Mount Desert Island during peak season.

### **Entrance Station Fees**

\$35.00 per vehicle for a 7-day pass

\$30.00 per motorcyclist for a 7-day pass

\$20.00 per individual with no car for a 7-day pass: (bicyclist, hiker or pedestrian).

\$70.00 per vehicle for an annual pass

\$80.00 Lifetime pass for citizens 62+ years

### **Cadillac Summit Road**

A vehicle reservation fee of \$6.00 needs to be paid along with your park pass to enter the road to the Cadillac Summit. This can be done at [Recreation.gov](#).

### **Park Loop Road**

This 26-mile drive includes Cadillac Mountain, Sand Beach, and Thunder Hole.

### **Hiking and Biking**

There are over 120 miles of hiking trails and 45 miles of carriage roads for biking.

### **Ranger-led Programs**

Ranger-guided programs provide the opportunity for visitors to learn more about the natural and cultural wonders of Acadia National Park. Most programs are offered from May to October; however, some programs do occur throughout the year. Schedules can be found on the [nps.gov/acad](#) website, or by asking at the Visitor Center, Nature Center, Park Headquarters, or campgrounds. Campground amphitheater programs are open to all visitors.
